#### IF YOU ARE ALREADY AN UNARMED GUARD:

The armed guard portion of the training will require another 4-8 hours at the Prescott Shooting Range and Gun Club, 1200 Iron Springs Rd, Prescott, AZ 86305. The cost of our training is \$175.00\*. DPS license cost is separate and payable to DPS. YOU MUST SHOW A WRITTEN OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT TO TAKE THE CLASS.

For the class you will need:

- 1. Semi-auto pistol. We recommend a 9mm.
- 2. Duty belt, nylon with velcro on outside. Nylon pants belt with velcro on inside. They seal each other.
- 3. Level 2 holster, double magazine carrier plus 2 or 3 magazines, handcuff carrier, at least one flashlight in carrier. A second flashlight should be somewhere easily accessible; "two is one, one is none." Batteries always go dead. Safariland makes an excellent Level 2 polymer holster.
- 5. 50 rounds of ammo.
- 6. Notebook and black pen.

### IF YOU ARE LOOKING FOR THE 2-YEAR RENEWAL:

This is a review of the armed guard graining with a 30-question quiz and 50-round range qualification. The cost of our training is \$175\*. DPS renewal cost is separate and payable to DPS.

# Appendix A Armed Security Guard Authorized Course of Fire - Handgun

This 50 round handgun qualification course requires a minimum passing score of at least 175 (70% of 250 maximum possible points), using an NRA TQ-15, TQ-19 or equivalent, i.e., secondary scoring ring equal to 14 x 16, or less. Shots to the head/neck within the secondary scoring ring count as hits. Shots impacting outside of the 2 scoring ring will not count. Each hit will count as 5 points. Students firing semiautomatic pistols may reload as needed, except for the final string at the 7-yard line, which is mandatory. All rounds will be fired using two hands. Ensure students understand what each start position is by demonstration.

### **PRE-Range Safety Briefing**

- Eyes and Ears must be ON, BEFORE entering Range area.
- NO LOADED firearms will pass through the Range entry/exit doors.
- Firearms will be loaded when the "Load and Make Ready" command is given.
- Firearms will NOT come out of the holster unless you are facing downrange and permission is granted, or the 'fire' command has been given.
- Firearms will not come out of the holster unless you are fully inside your lane cubicle, behind the line and standing on the lane pad.
- When your shooting qualification is completed, you will be instructed to "Unload and make safe", then holster your empty firearm. (No magazine)
- When ready, you will be given the command when to collect your belongings and we all exit together.
- Be aware there will be at least one 'Range Safety Officer' monitoring the range activity, and he will callout violations as they occur, that I may miss.

One violation of these rules will result in disqualification. You will then have to leave the range, to return another day.

### Never forget the four rules of handgun safety:

- 1. Every gun is always loaded.
- 2. Do NOT point at anything you do not wish to destroy.
- 3. Do NOT put your finger on the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- 4. Be sure of your target and beyond.
